**University of Redlands Information:**

- Completion of the articulated courses is **optional** prior to transfer and can be completed at University of Redlands.
- University of Redlands admission requirements to the undergraduate Business programs are: 40 units of accepted transferable and assessment credits, minimum 2.0 GPA, and 3 years full time work experience.
- Students who matriculate to the University of Redlands School of Business directly from Palomar Community College District, transferring in at least 21 credits earned at Palomar College, will be offered a 10% tuition discount for classes attended at School of Business facilities provided they meet all admission requirements and student accounts remain current.
