The following list will assist you in choosing courses to fulfill lower-division general education transfer requirements for transfer to the University of California (UC) or the California State University (CSU). Some UC campuses may not allow use of the IGETC for students who were previously enrolled at a UC campus.

- All courses used on the IGETC require a grade of "C" or better. A "C-" grade is **not** acceptable.
- A course may be certified in one area only.
- Course work completed prior to Fall 1991 may be used on the IGETC if the course appears on the 1991-92 IGETC Course List.
- Course work completed in Fall 1992 or later may be used according to the approval dates as noted.
- IGETC may not be appropriate for select major preparation patterns. Consult a counselor for details.

Students must request certification:

Submit a Graduation Petition to the Evaluations Office in the Student Services Center, SSC-40. See application deadline dates below.
