

## Palomar College Financial Aid Summer 2013 Pell Grant Information Sheet

To meet Summer 2013 Pell Grant eligibility at Palomar College, students must:

- be pursuing an eligible declared program of study at Palomar College, AND
- have successfully met 2012-2013 financial aid academic progress standards\*, AND
- have completed the **2012-2013** FAFSA and all Palomar College Financial Aid documentation requirements by June 27, 2013. Pell eligibility will be determined by the Palomar Financial Aid Office (EFC must be less than 4996); AND
- have funds remaining from **2012-2013** Pell Grant maximum annual eligibility; ALSO
- have completed all Summer 2013 enrollment activity (adds and drops) by June 23, 2013, AND
- have Pell eligibility based on the student's EFC and active enrollment during the 6-/8-week session of Summer 2013 (June 17 – August 12)

**Enrollment Status:** (based on federal aid regulations, Palomar Financial Aid applies the same definition to ALL periods of enrollment – Fall, Spring, and Summer)

<½-time:	0.5 – 5.5 units	¾-time:	9.0 – 11.5 units
½-time:	6.0 – 8.5 units	full-time:	12.0 units or more

Classes must meet the student's declared educational goal as determined on the student's Palomar College Education Plan.

### **Notification and Calculation of Summer 2013 Eligibility:**

Students who were disbursed Pell Grant at Palomar College for Fall 2012 and/or Spring 2013 will be included on a Financial Aid report to determine who has unused eligibility. ALL Spring 2013 grades must be officially posted and reviewed (anticipated by June 7, 2013) to finalize eligibility. If eligible, notification will be sent through the student's Palomar College student e-mail account. If ineligible, students will have been notified separately, e.g., Aid Disqualified/Denied.

Students who are NOT awarded Pell Grant at Palomar College for Fall 2012 and/or Spring 2013 by May 10 must submit a Summer 2013 Pell Grant Interest Sheet to the Financial Aid Office by June 27, 2013. As soon as eligibility can be determined, notification will be sent through the student's Palomar College student e-mail account.

### **Payment of Summer 2013 Pell Grant (split into 2 payments):**

- The first 50% is scheduled for mail-out on June 27
- The second disbursement is scheduled for mail-out on July 25

Adjustments to the student's enrollment schedule will be taken into account and may increase, decrease or eliminate the award. Any student who missed the first disbursement date will be issued 100% on the second date, if eligibility has been maintained.

Failure to attend all classes enrolled in as of June 23 could trigger partial or full repayment of funds.

### **\*Students disqualified prior to Summer 2013:**

As written in the Financial Aid 2012-2013 Satisfactory Academic Progress policy, students who have been disqualified from aid eligibility have the right to Appeal. However, federal regulations require the existence of extenuating circumstances which caused the disqualification and documentation of those circumstances must be attached to the Appeal. The deadline to submit an Appeal for Summer 2013 is July 1, 2013.
