FACULTY SEMINAR GUIDELINES

Faculty must provide the seminar dates for Video classes. The following guidelines will help determine when video lessons are broadcast, so that seminars can be appropriately scheduled.

- Video lessons are broadcast on holidays.
- The first week's lessons **will repair the second week.**
- Two VIDEO classes will be scheduled in the same room wherever possible and will generally share their room during the weeknights.
- If your department/program is offering more than one VIDEO class with seminar meetings held on the same day of the week, please schedule them on alternate dates and in the same room wherever possible.
- **Schedule the last seminar using the guidelines listed below:**
 After April 30, for classes with 24-26 video lessons
 After May 14, for classes with 30 video lessons
 After April 30, for classes with 36 video lessons
- Faculty should first select either **Option A** or **Option B** for their seminar dates. Next, select the exact dates from **within that option** depending on the number of seminars needed for the class. For example, if the class usually has 6 seminar meetings on Tuesday evening, and if Option A is selected, the faculty member would select 6 seminar dates from among those listed for Option A for Tuesday evening.
