### PLEASE BE ADVISED - Restrictions for Course Repeatability

- Before you decide to drop, withdraw from, or repeat a class, discuss it with a counselor, financial aid advisor, or veteran's advisor. Always consider the consequences before you remove yourself from a class.
- Repeating a course will affect your financial aid eligibility or veterans' educational benefits. Consult with financial aid or veterans services staff.
- Drops and withdrawals up to and including the 'Last day to drop without a grade' result in the course not being reflected on your academic transcript.
- Withdrawals after the drop deadline will be reflected as an enrollment on your academic transcript with a "W" grade.
- Academic History - These new regulations do not contain a grandfather clause. Past enrollment attempts count toward the enrollment limits. If you already have reached the maximum number of attempts on a specific course, your enrollment will be blocked.

### While Registering for classes ... You May Encounter Error Messages.

#### Registration Error Messages

##### Satisfactory Grade

Course was previously passed with a satisfactory grade.

##### Course with Related Content

Courses related in content limit exceeded.

##### Repeatable Courses

Repeat limit exceeded.

##### Withdrawals

"W" grade limit exceeded.

##### Cooperative Work Experience

16-unit limit exceeded.

### Rules for Courses with Related Content Impact Visual and Performing Arts, Kinesiology

Many Visual Arts, Performing Arts, and Kinesiology courses have been grouped based upon having related content\*.

- Art (ART) • Art Design (ARTD) • Art Illustration (ARTI) • Dance (DNCE) • Entertainment Technology (ENTT)
- Kinesiology (KINE) • Music (MUS) • Theatre Arts (TA)

\* Courses with related content are clusters of courses that limit enrollment to four attempts for the group including completions, withdrawals, and incompletes. **Course Repetition Changes** - Due to changes in the regulations that govern California Community Colleges, limits have been placed on the number of times you may enroll in a course.
