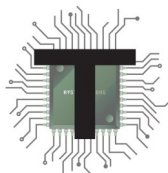

**COUNSELOR'S MESSAGE**

Are you planning to apply for transfer this Fall 2017? CSU applications can be submitted any time now but no later than November 30 through <http://www.csumentor.edu>. UC applications can be submitted between November 1 and November 30 through <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/>. For private universities, check each institution's specific deadlines. If the private university requires the "common application," then get started on it sooner than later. Make an appointment with a counselor at the STEM Center or visit the [Transfer Center](#) to make sure you are on the right track. The Transfer Center will also host various university representatives from institutions like UCSD, CSUSM, and SDSU. Contact the Transfer Center to make an appointment to meet with these representatives.
