- 7. Reports:**
 - a. **Photo Club:** Met with Shaun from Planetarium last week to set up a field trip to the planetarium to do some night shooting. They have some jigs so that we can hook up our cameras directly to the telescopes, so we're going to be doing that. We did discuss doing the indigenous booth, but like we said, we were just too busy and given such little notice. Next meeting, next Thursday at 2:30pm in the photo lab.

- e. **Transitions Collective:** We had a meeting on Thursday and we discussed a retreat we're having this weekend, on Saturday, at CSUSM.
- f. **Native American Student Alliance:** Our meeting on Thursday, we went over the Indigenous People's Day and our involvement and what we'd like to do. We talked about tabling as well as other events to get our club going and our future involvement with events on campus.
- g. **Women in Leadership:** We are in the process of finalizing our first event where we will be holding a panel at Political Economies Day thanks to Kelly. It's going good, we have our first meeting with new members today
- h. **PUENTE:** We met on Wednesday and discussed our options for our Chicanos in medicine event that we're having and we're still deciding on a date for that.
- i. **Palomar Film Club:** We are having a meeting next week on Monday at 2:30 in Q-2. We are actually collaborating with the Health Center on upcoming screening called *Resilience* on mental health on November 6th. It's in the afternoon, I believe it begins around 3 o'clock if you want to join us. We're also branching out to the Rancho Bernardo Campus, we're currently working on that. - m. **Palomar Chemistry Club:** Last night we had our biweekly meeting. We discussed the Science Fair at San Marcos Middle School outreach timeline for November 7th is when the science fair is going to be there.
