- Chair Natasha Copple brings up the idea of starting a Discord for all ICC groups to have better communication throughout the week.
- Young Americans for Liberty brought up the idea of each club having their own channel on the server.
- Women in Computer Science asks what Discord is.
- Copple says it is an app on the phone or computer that's basically a group chat.
- Women in Computer Science brought up the idea of restrictions for the app.
- Copple mentioned limiting to only ICC or club members.
- Advisor Kelly Donaghy noted that students will still need to adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, be appropriate. Also, no voting in the app. All actions and approval must be brought to ICC. Discord is just a platform of discussion
- Tech Club brought up the idea of having moderators to monitor the content on the app and make sure there are no violations and such.
- Ceramic Arts Association asks about brief sessions on the app. Doesn't know what the app is.
- Copple says she would be willing to help out and it's a simple piece of software to use and can be used on computer as well.
- Transitions Collective asks if all the clubs members be able to access it?

- Cople says they will try to only keep to ICC delegates. Want to keep it as small as possible.
- Young Americans for Liberty suggests setting up restrictions and monitoring of things posted using settings.
- Guest Linus Smith suggests for every club to select up to 3 other members for the ICC discord.
- Tech Club asks if they can also include club officers?
- Cople says she thinks ICC Delegate and 2 others is sufficient. Preferably people that intend to be a part of the ICC meetings and not the entire club group. Maybe the club president and vice president but to limit it to ICC members.

Discussion:

- Photo Club brings up the point that the club representatives should be able to actively communicate with their members. Too many people will result in constant notifications.
- Young Americans for Liberty agrees.
- Rhetoric Symposium suggests the president and then 3 delegates as the presidents needs to know what's going on at all times. Still trying to keep the Discord members small.
- Donaghy says that the ICC representative, club president, and one other person is sufficient and efficient. Trust representative to communicate with the rest of the clubs.
- Tech Club asks if there is an option where members of the club could only read what happens in the Discord, but not actually chat.
- Smith says that he doubts all the club members will even want to hear about what is going on at the ICC meetings. If they do, however, then it is all of your responsibilities to keep them informed, because that is in fact your duty as Delegates of your clubs.
- MEChA says that three is too much but if there are any miscommunications there's always the option of screenshotting and showing.
- Women in Computer Science says having the option of 3 slots max is necessary for clubs whose members take turns to attend ICC meetings.
- Women in Leadership says she agrees, one person plus an alternate should be enough.

- Women in Computer Science says that just because there are three maximum, that does not mean that every club has to use three slots. So she believes that three is an okay number.

a. ICC Club Reports (2 min max)
