

1. Future of DACA

DACA remains in effect until January 20, 2017. It is unknown at this time if it will continue under the Trump Presidency.

President-elect Trump stated he will end all of President Obama's executive actions, including DACA. Until he takes office, this remains uncertain.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a) **For all 1st time applicants:** HOLD OFF on applying for DACA because the application process timeframe will fall under new administration. The reality is there are 70 days until the end of the Obama administration. This does not leave enough time to process new applications.
- b) **DACA Renewals:** Encourage this
- c) **Advanced parole approval:** okay to travel but return before January 20, 2017. If you have not applied, it is recommended that you HOLD OFF.

2. ICE

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a) If ICE comes, do not open your door! They have to have a warrant.
- b) Remain silent. Remember, anything can be used against you. Use the 5th Amendment.
- c) Do not sign anything without an attorney!
- d) Report and record. Take pictures and video. Record everything; name, badge #, type of car, etc. Call United We Dream hotline to report any occurrences 1-844-363-1423
- e) Remember: **YOU ARE NOT ALONE.** We all have allies.

3. Sanctuary Schools

- a) Create pressure from the bottom up to Administration
- b) Create sanctuary in classrooms if needed
- c) Recognize and organize by connecting to other schools

4. Mental Health/Suicide Prevention

What can we do to help?

- a) Create welcome spaces
- b) Recommend check-in with friends and family
- c) Ask "How can I support you?"
- d) Inform students and their families about their rights
- e) Distribute toolkits <http://unitedwedream.org/?s=toolkit>
- f) Partner with proper authorities, such as campus police and/or administration, to see what their policies are.
- g) Provide counseling and resources
