Key Responsibilities

In addition, the intern will become more knowledgeable about various resources to assist with basic needs.

Minimal qualifications for the intern are to be basic computer competent, display high integrity and confidentiality, have interest in social/community work, has ability to manage and overcome sensitive situations. The intern will also need to demonstrate writing and literacy competent, as well as have a minimum of a cumulative 2.50 GPA.
