The following list will assist you in choosing courses to fulfill lower-division general education breadth requirements for transfer to any California State University (CSU). GE Breadth requires a minimum of 39 lower-division semester units, which may be certified by California Community Colleges. Partial certification may be granted by Area (A, B, C, D, or E) or full certification may be granted if all areas and units are completed.

- A course may be certified in one area only.
- The course must be on the list at the time it was completed.
- Consult a counselor for specific information regarding major prep and additional GE requirements.

Submit a Graduation Petition to the Evaluations Office in the Student Services Center, SSC-40. See application deadline dates below.
