Dear Palomar College Employees –

In the wake of continued concern with COVID-19, Palomar College decided to continue with primarily online instruction for Fall 2020. All areas of the college are working to provide the smoothest and safest experience possible for our students, staff, and faculty. Although nearly all classes will be held online, the chairs and deans have been working hard to determine which courses have to have at least some part of their curriculum held face-to-face and to limit their time on-campus to the extent possible, and our ADAs have spent a lot of time entering changes to our original schedule.

As of June 15, we have 2832 sections scheduled. Of those sections, no more than 300 will have some face-to-face on-campus presence for labs only. Our Police and Fire Academies will continue at Santar, and EME will be held at Escondido with some Air Conditioning courses taking place at the Escondido Center as well. All other courses having some on-campus presence will be held at the San Marcos campus. Those courses currently include Nursing, Dental Assisting, Microbiology, CTE, Graphics, Performing Arts, and Kinesiology/Athletics; buildings impacted are HS, NS, MD, ITC, O, PAC, D, T, and possibly the Dome.
