



Dear Palomar College Student,

I hope this communication finds you safe and well. Palomar College remains laser focused on protecting your health and safety. To this end, on June 23, 2020, the Palomar Community College District Board of Trustees voted unanimously to approve *Resolution No. 19-21574 authorizing the Implementation of Temperature and Symptom Screening of Students, Staff, and Faculty During the Coronavirus (Covid-19) Pandemic.*

In accordance with the resolution, effective Monday, July 20, 2020, all students, staff, faculty and authorized visitors entering a campus or education center are required to have their temperature taken and to be screened for symptoms of COVID-19. We have designed touchless screening stations in both a drive-thru and walk-up format.

Below is a list of screening station locations and current hours of operation. The hours of operation are based on the class schedule and will be updated as needed on the COVID-19 [website](#).

Escondido Education Center Parking Lot #3	Monday thru Thursday & Saturday 7:00 a.m. – 8:30a.m.	Walk-Up
	Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.	Walk-Up

Once you are screened you will be provided a sticker to wear while you are on campus or at the Escondido Education Center. You are also required to wear a facial covering and maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance from other students, and faculty and staff members.

When screened, if your temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher, and/or have symptoms of COVID-19, you will be asked to return home, self-quarantine and depending on the severity of your condition, seek medical care.
