As we remain focused on your health and safety, COVID-19 cases continue to increase in San Diego County and throughout California, we have determined that our Fall 2020 face-to-face course list will ONLY include courses that are designed to educate and train first responders and emergency care workers. All other classes will be held online. Unfortunately, some classes that were originally scheduled for the fall semester may not be offered.

Our Police and Fire Academies will continue at the training center at Santar, and Emergency Medical Education will be held at Escondido. In addition, to provide continuity in program for our nursing students, Biology 212 will be offered onsite, as will the labs required for our Dental Assisting Program. These are the only labs that will be offered at the main campus.

It is also appropriate to let you know that all fall athletics have been postponed until Spring 2021. Related courses will be offered online to the extent possible.
