Vaccine Update

Vaccine Super Station Coming To North County

A vaccine Super Station is coming to North County in San Marcos!

Starting Sunday, January 31, North County's Vaccination Super Station will open on the Cal State San Marcos campus, with the capabilities of vaccinating up to 5,000 individuals a day. (Appointments Only)

Please check the site on Saturday (around noon) for appointments to open. We know that appointments have been filling up quickly, but this Super Station will allow many more to become vaccinated. More information to follow, but keep an eye out at vaccinationsuperstationsd.com

Everyone should first try to coordinate with their healthcare provider, as they have their own allotment of vaccines.

Also, you can still register to get vaccinated at the Oceanside POD. The Oceanside location can administer 500 vaccines a day. You can register at, www.vaccinationsuperstationsd.com

TIP: Try and make an appointment around noon - new appointments become available mid-day for three days out.

Phase 1B Vaccinating NOW**

- **1B-Tier 1:**
 - Persons aged 75 years and older
 - Persons aged 65 years and older

Phase 1A-Tier 1 Vaccinating NOW*

- Acute care, psychiatric, and **correctional facility hospitals**⁺
- Skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities, and similar settings for older or medically vulnerable individuals
 - Include residents in these settings as recommended for Phase 1A by ACIP
- Paramedics, EMTs, and others providing emergency medical services
- Dialysis centers
- Behavioral health residential facilities
- Vaccinators

Phase 1A-Tier 2 Vaccinating NOW*

- Intermediate care, for persons who need non-continuous nursing supervision, and supportive care
- Home healthcare and in-home supportive services
- Community health workers, including promotoras
- Public health field staff
- Primary care clinics, including Federally Qualified Health Centers, Rural Health Centers, correctional facility clinics, and urgent care clinics
- Behavioral health non-residential or outpatient facilities

Phase 1A-Tier 3 Vaccinating NOW*

Other settings and healthcare personnel not identified in Phase 1A-Tier 1 or Phase 1A-Tier 2, including:

- Specialty clinics, **laboratory workers** ⁺⁺, dental/oral health clinics, pharmacy staff, and funeral workers and **others**.
