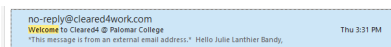


Instructions* for Accessing Health Pre-Screen Questionnaire with email from no-reply@cleared4work.com

who are not required to test for COVID-19.**

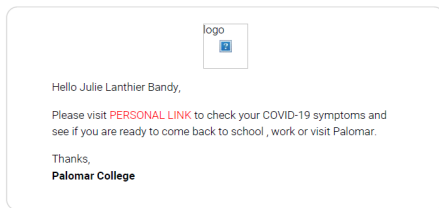

- Locate and open Welcome email from no-reply@cleared4work.com or a text message from **833-635-1086**. NOTE: the link contained in the Welcome email is YOUR PERSONAL LINK. Please do not forward this link to anyone. It contains information specific to you.

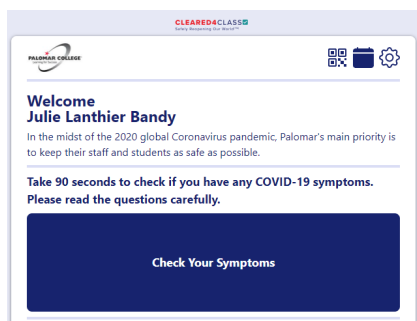

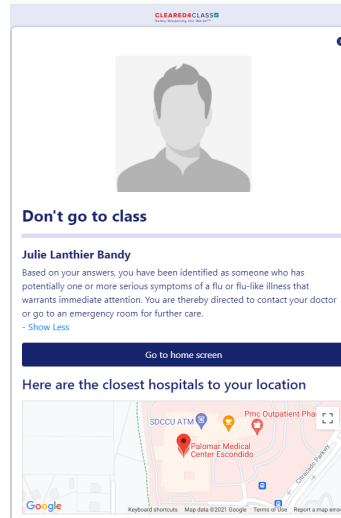
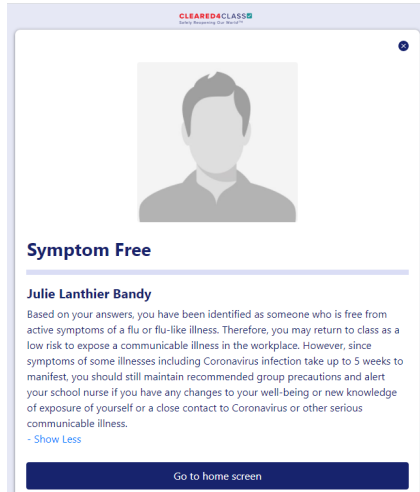

- Once you click on the provided link, you will have immediate access to the Daily Health Questionnaire. Please respond to all questions.



- Based on your answers, you will receive the appropriate response from Cleared4. As noted above, we are working to add copy that is specific to Palomar College. For example, the “Don’t go to class” copy will be updated to “Don’t go to class or work” and you will be asked to complete a COVID-19 questionnaire if you are symptomatic, potentially exposed to COVID-19, etc.
- After you receive your results, you may click on “Go to home screen” to view your pass and proceed to any other steps necessary.



- This is your home screen. If you “Click to Show Status” you will receive the appropriate “pass or no pass”.
