Minimum Requirements

- 2.5 Minimum GPA
- Essay Questions
- Unofficial Transcript
- Reference Letter is no longer required!

Step 1: Opt-In

Log in to your eServices account and click on the “Scholarship Application Opt-In” link located under the section “My Finances and Financial Assistance”. By opting in you are consenting to share your student data with Blackbaud Award Management and scholarship donors so we can accurately match you to the scholarships we administer. Student data will be sent to Blackbaud Award Management on a nightly basis.

Step 2: Sign-Up

Students that opt-in will be able to select the “Apply for scholarships” link on eServices on the *next day*. You will have to sign up with Blackbaud Award Management by creating an account using your Palomar student email address and password.

Step 3: Follow-Up

Be sure you upload your unofficial academic transcript(s) by March 1st. These items must be submitted within the scholarships application using the available links and instructions. This includes your Palomar unofficial transcript. If you have under 12 college credits completed, please upload your unofficial High School transcript.
