FALL 2020 TAG to UC Davis



TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee) is a written agreement that guarantees admission to UC Davis for the fall quarter in a given major.

MAJORS GUARANTEED FOR UCD- Open to all UC Davis majors (both selective and non-selective) **except** Undeclared/Exploratory program.

Selective Majors: All majors in the College of Engineering, College of Biological Sciences, and some majors in the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (Biotechnology, Viticulture and Enology) and College of Letters and Sciences (Applied Physics, Physics, Computer Science, Mathematics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Psychology, Computer Science). Students will not be held to courses not articulated with Palomar College. Landscape Architecture candidates apply as pre-landscape architecture majors and do not have specific course requirements but must have a 3.2 cumulative GPA.

UCD TAG REQUIREMENTS:

1. Have completed a minimum of 30 UC transferable semester units (including units for AP & IB) with a **minimum GPA of 3.2 – 3.3** (3.3 for the College of Engineering) by the end of Summer 2019.
2. Students must have been enrolled at a CCC in the Spring 2019, Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters. Full time enrollment is strongly recommended. Students who attend part time for any of these terms need to provide an explanation on their TAG application.
3. Be enrolled in at least 12 units at Palomar in the Fall semester if the TAG indicates Palomar College.
4. Complete with a “C” or better by the end of the Fall 2019 semester:
 - 2 UC transferable English composition courses: Palomar College English 100 and English 202 or 203 or Philosophy 200. Only 1 AP or IB exam may be used towards this requirement
 - One (1) UC transferable mathematics course (from IGETC Area 2)
5. Complete by the end of the Spring 2020 semester:
 - Four (4) UC transferable courses chosen from at least two of the following areas: Arts and Humanities, Social and Behavioral Sciences, Biological and Physical Sciences (IGETC Areas 3, 4, 5). Reference 7-Course Pattern.
 - Those courses required for admission into selective UC Davis majors
 - A minimum of 60 UC transferable units with at least 30 having been earned at a CCC
 - All major course requirements with a letter grade of “C” or better
6. The last college of attendance must be a California Community College during a Fall or Spring Semester.
7. Once TAG is submitted, students may not fall below the minimum required overall GPA and may not receive grades below a C.
8. Apply for the TAG at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students/> **September 1-30, 2019.**
9. Students must meet with a Transfer Center Counselor in September 2019 to review the submitted TAG.

10. Submit a UC undergraduate application at <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/applicant/login.htm> in Nov 1-30, 2019. Students must apply to the same major for which the TAG is approved in order to guarantee admission.
11. Complete the Transfer Academic Update at <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/after-you-apply/index.html> in January 2020.
12. Follow through with all requests and deadlines specified from UCD until transferred.

Students are ineligible for the UCD TAG if they:

- Have accumulated **80 or more** UC transferable semester units of combined 4-year and community college coursework, (excluding AP/IB credits) after applying lower division unit limitations & exclusions (**unit limit does not apply to majors in the College of Engineering**)- students who have only attended a CCC have no unit restriction.
- Are a former UC student **not** in “good standing” at UC campus previously attended (less than 2.0 GPA at UC)
- Are a former **UC Davis** student (not including summer session)
- Have earned a bachelor’s degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree
- Are attending a CCC while simultaneously working towards high school graduation at the time of TAG submission
- Are simultaneously enrolled at a CCC and a baccalaureate institution when the TAG is submitted up until the time of enrollment at UCD
