

UCI's Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program guarantees admission to highly qualified students from all California Community Colleges. Admission to most majors at UCI can be guaranteed through TAG for transfer students who meet the eligibility requirements and complete the online TAG application.

Majors guaranteed for TAG: The UCI TAG is only applicable for the primary major indicated on the TAG form. Specific major preparation requirements are detailed by schools at: <https://www.admissions.uci.edu/apply/transfer/requirements.php>

Majors that do not participate in TAG at UCI:

Business Administration, Cognitive Sciences, Dance, Language Science, Music, Nursing Science, Psychology B.S. and all majors in the Donald Bren School of Information and Computer Sciences **do not** participate in TAG.

UCI TAG Requirements:

1. Earn a minimum GPA of **3.4** in all UC transferable coursework by the end of the Summer 2019 term and maintain a 3.4 GPA in all UC transferable coursework for all subsequent terms.
2. By the end of the Summer 2019 term:
 - Complete 30 semester or 45 quarter UC transferable units (including AP/IB/A-level)
 - Complete one UC transferable English course with a grade of "C" or better
 - Complete one UC transferable math course with a grade of "C" or better
3. By the end of Spring 2020 semester:
 - Complete a second UC transferable English course with a grade of "C" or better: English 202 or 203 or PHIL 200
 - Complete 60 UC transferable semester units or 90 UC transferable quarter units
 - Complete 4 UC courses from at least 2 of the 4 IGETC areas 3, 4, 5. Reference 7-Course Pattern.
 - Complete all major coursework for your chosen major, including course prerequisites and maintain minimum course GPA through the end of the Spring 2020 term
4. Be in good standing for all colleges attended and satisfy all UC transfer eligibility requirements.
5. The last college of attendance must be a California Community College during a Fall or Spring Semester.
6. Complete the last 30 semester or 45 quarter units at a California Community College by the end of the Spring 2020 term for Fall 2020 admission.
7. Apply for the TAG at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students/> **September 1-30, 2019.**
8. Submit a UC undergraduate application at <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/applicant/login.htm> in Nov 1-30, 2019.
9. Apply to the same major for which the TAG is approved in order to guarantee admission.
10. Complete the Transfer Academic Update at <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/after-you-apply/index.html> in January 2020.
11. Follow through with all requests and deadlines specified from UCI until transferred.

Students are ineligible for the UCI TAG if they:

- Have accumulated **90 or more** UC transferable semester units of combined 4-year university and Community College coursework, (excluding AP/IB credits) after applying lower division unit limitations & exclusions
- Are a former UC student **not** in "good standing" at UC campus previously attended (less than 2.0 GPA at UC)
- Have previously enrolled at UCI during a regular term (not including summer session)
- Have earned a bachelor's degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree
- Are attending a CCC while simultaneously working towards high school graduation at the time of TAG submission
- Were enrolled at a UC Campus during a regular term (not summer) who plans to return to that campus.
