



TAG is an agreement between Palomar College and select UC campuses which guarantees admission to upper division transfer applicants for select quarters only. UCM allows transfers for Fall and Spring quarters.

MAJORS GUARANTEED FOR UCM:

Yes, all majors are guaranteed except Critical Race & Ethnic Studies, English, Global Arts Studies Program, Public Health, Philosophy, and Spanish. The minimum GPAs listed below must be earned by the end of summer 2019 and maintained through spring 2020.

- 3.0 GPA required for all majors in the School of Engineering
- 2.9 GPA for all majors in the School of Natural Sciences
- 2.8 GPA for all majors in the School of Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts except Psychology with 3.0 GPA

UCM TAG REQUIREMENTS:

1. At the time of TAG Submission:
 - Be enrolled Full time at a California Community college
 - Have at least 30 UC transferrable units completed
 - Met the minimum GPA required for your major
2. **By end of Fall 2019:**
 - Complete with a “C” grade or better Palomar College’s English 100 Complete with a “C”
 - Complete a UC transferrable math class from IGETC Area 2
3. **By end of Spring 2020:**
 - Complete the 2nd English composition course chosen from English 202 or 203 or Philosophy 200
 - No more than 1 major prep course where a grade of No Pass, D or F was received (even if repeated)
 - Complete four UC transferable courses chosen from at least two of the following areas: arts and humanities (IGETC Area 3); social and behavioral sciences (IGETC Area 4); biological and physical sciences (IGETC Area 5). Reference “7- Course Pattern.”
 - No more than 2 total withdrawals in major prep courses
 - Complete a minimum 60 UC transferable units. At least 30 of these 60 semester units must be completed in residence at a CCC
 - Complete required prep for the major
 - No unrepeatable grades of No Pass, D or F in CCC transfer work
 - Complete at least 50% of the required coursework for your major: <https://admissions.ucmerced.edu/transfer/major-preparation-schools>
4. Be enrolled at a California Community College (CCC) at the time the TAG is submitted.
5. The last college of attendance must be a California Community College during a fall or spring semester.
6. Complete a minimum of 30 units at one or more California Community Colleges at the time of TAG submission.
7. Apply for the TAG at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students/> in **September 1-30, 2019**.
8. Submit a UC undergraduate application at <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/applicant/login.htm> in **Nov 1-30, 2019**. Students must apply to the same major for which the TAG is approved in order to guarantee admission.
9. Complete the Transfer Academic Update at: <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/after-you-apply/index.html> in **January 2020**.
10. Follow through with all requests and deadlines specified from UCM until transferred.

Students are ineligible for the UCM TAG if they:

- Have accumulated 79 or more UC transferable semester units of combined 4-year and community college coursework, (excluding AP/IB credits) after applying lower division unit limitations & exclusions
- Are a former UC student **not** in “good standing” at UC campus previously attended (less than 2.0 GPA at UC)
- Are a former **UCM** student (not including summer session)
- Have earned a bachelor’s degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree
- Are attending a CCC while simultaneously working towards high school graduation at the time of TAG submission
- Are simultaneously enrolled at a CCC and a baccalaureate institution when the TAG is submitted up until the time of enrollment at UCM
