

**UCRs Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)** is a written agreement that guarantees admission to UC Riverside for upper division transfers in select quarters.

**Majors guaranteed for TAG:** All majors at UCR, except Art (Studio,) are guaranteed with TAG.

Complete required major preparation for your intended major. For major selection criteria, visit <https://admissions.ucr.edu/transfer/majors-preparation-guide>. Selecting majors include all majors in the Bourn College of Engineering (BCOE), College of Natural & Agricultural Sciences (CNAS), the school of Business Administration (SB) and CHASS (Economics, Business Economics, Neuro Science, and Psychology).

**UCR TAG Requirements:**

1. Earn the minimum required GPA for the college of the intended major:
  - 2.8 for the College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (CHASS)
  - 3.0 plus major preparation for the Marlan and Rosemary Bourns College of Engineering (BCOE)
  - 2.8 plus major preparation for the College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences (CNAS)
  - 3.0 plus major preparation for the School of Business (SB)
  - 2.7 for the Graduate School of Education (GSOE)
  - 2.7 for the School of Public Policy
2. At the time of submitting the TAG- have 30 semester or 45 quarter UC Transferable units including AP & IB.
3. By the end of the Fall 2019 semester:
  - Complete one UC transferable English course (Palomar’s English 100 or the equivalent) with a grade of “C” or better
  - Complete one UC transferable math course from IGETC area 2 with a grade of “C” or better
  - Students applying to a selecting major (all majors in BCOE, CNAS, Business majors, and CHASS Economics, Business Economics, Psychology and Neuroscience) must have minimum mathematics for major complete by end of Fall 2019.
4. By the end of Spring 2020 semester:
  - Complete a second UC transferable English course with a grade of “C” or better: English 202 or 203 or PHIL 200
  - Complete a minimum of 60 UC transferable semester units or 90 UC transferable quarter units
  - Complete 4 UC courses from at least 2 of the 4 IGETC areas 3, 4, 5. Reference “7-Course Pattern.”
  - Students to the School of Business Administration must have IGETC completed
5. You must maintain the required GPA for your intended major.
6. Be in good standing at all colleges attended and satisfy all UC transfer eligibility requirements.
7. Meet the definition of a CCC transfer student as a student who has completed more than half of his or her units at a California Community College. The last college of attendance must be a California Community College at the time of TAG submission.
8. All students including International students with a visa must transfer directly from a California Community College
9. Apply for the TAG at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students/> **September 1-30, 2019.**
10. Submit a UC undergraduate application at <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/applicant/login.htm> in Nov 1-30, 2019.
11. Apply to the same major for which the TAG is approved in order to guarantee admission.
12. Complete the Transfer Academic Update at <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/after-you-apply/index.html> in January 2020.
13. Follow through with all requests and deadlines specified from UCI until transferred.

**Students are ineligible for the UCR TAG if they:**

- Have accumulated **80 or more** UC transferable semester units of combined 4-year university and Community College coursework, (excluding AP/IB credits) after applying lower division unit limitations & exclusions
- Are a former UC student **not** in “good standing” at UC campus previously attended (less than 2.0 GPA at UC)
- Have previously enrolled at UCR during a regular term (not including summer session)
- Have earned a bachelor’s degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree
- Are attending a CCC while simultaneously working towards high school graduation at the time of TAG submission
