



TAG is an agreement between Palomar College and select UC campuses which guarantees admission to upper division transfer applicants for select quarters only. UCSB allows transfers for Fall quarter only.

MAJORS GUARANTEED FOR UCSB:

Most majors in the College of Letters & Science (to majors that do not have a pre-major) are guaranteed. Those majors with a pre-major are guaranteed but into the pre-major where more requirements must be met at UCSB after transfer to be accepted into the full major.

The following Economics, Mathematics & Biological Sciences majors have minimum GPA & major prep requirements which can be found at www.assist.org (in the Admission Selection Criteria section):

- Aquatic Biology B.S., Biochemistry-Molecular Biology B.S., Biological Sciences B.A. and B.S., Cell and Developmental Biology B.S., Ecology and Evolution B.S., Microbiology B.S., Pharmacology B.S., Physiology B.S., Zoology B.S. Economics B.A., Economics and Accounting B.A., Mathematical Sciences B.S., Mathematics B.A., Mathematics B.S.

There are no TAG guarantees in:

- Dance B.A., Dance B.F.A., Music B.M., Theater B.F.A. in the College of Letters & Science
- All majors in the College of Creative Studies
- All majors in the College of Engineering. (Chemical Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical or Mechanical Engineering)

UCSB TAG REQUIREMENTS:

1. **3.4 over all GPA for all majors by the end of Fall 2019.**
2. **By end of Fall 2019-** must complete with a "C" grade or better:
 - Palomar College's English 100
 - One UC transferable mathematics course (from IGETC Area 2)
2. **By end of Spring 2020:**
 - Complete a second English competition course chosen from ENG 202, 203 or PHIL 200
 - Complete four UC transferable courses chosen from at least two of the following areas: arts and humanities (IGETC Area 3), social and behavioral sciences (IGETC Area 4), biological and physical sciences (IGETC Area 5). Reference 7 Course Pattern.
 - Complete a minimum 60 UC transferable units. 30 of 60 semester units must be completed in residence at a CCC with no more than 18 units in Spring 2020 to reach this unit requirement
3. Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework in Fall 2019, Spring 2020 with no grade below a "C".
4. Be enrolled at a California Community College (CCC) at the time the TAG is submitted.
5. The last college of attendance must be a California Community College during a Fall or Spring Semester
6. Complete a minimum 60 UC transferable units and the seven-course pattern required for admission as a junior transfer.
7. Complete a minimum of 30 units at one or more California Community Colleges before TAG submission.
8. Once TAG is submitted, students may not fall below the minimum required overall GPA and may not receive grades below a "C".
9. Apply for the TAG at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students/> **in September 1-30, 2019.**
10. Submit a UC undergraduate application at <https://admissions.universityofcalifornia.edu/applicant/login.htm> **in Nov 1-30, 2019.** Students must apply to the same major for which the TAG is approved in order to guarantee admission.
11. Complete the Transfer Academic Update at: <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/after-you-apply/index.html> **in January 2020.**
12. Follow through with all requests and deadlines specified from UCSB until transferred.

Students are ineligible for the UCSB TAG if they:

- Have accumulated 90 **or more** UC transferable semester units of combined 4-year and community college coursework, (excluding AP/IB credits) after applying lower division unit limitations & exclusions
- Are a former UC student **not** in "good standing" at UC campus previously attended (less than 2.0 GPA at UC)
- Are a former **UCSB** student (not including summer session)
- Have earned a bachelor's degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree
- Are attending a CCC while simultaneously working towards high school graduation at the time of TAG submission
- Are simultaneously enrolled at a CCC and a baccalaureate institution when the TAG is submitted up until the time of enrollment at UCSB
