## Week 15 Assignment: ASL 100L

- 1. Review and memorize vocabulary in <u>Learning American Sign Language (LASL)</u> 1-11 and <u>Signing Naturally</u> Units 1-7. Drill yourself on vocabulary until recognition of each sign is automatic. Go over your class and lab notes. If your teacher has taught you any signs that are not in either book, take time to remember and practice them now.
- 2. Read the glossed representation of the signed dialogues in Unit 12 of Learning American Sign Language (LASL). Work with one dialogue at a time. Copy the signers until you are comfortable signing each dialogue on your own.
- 3. After signing the dialogues in Unit 12, read the grammar and cultural information and take notes.
- 4. Practice signing all exercises in Unit 12. Be sure to use complete sentences and appropriate facial expression.
- 5. Complete workbook exercises in <u>Signing Naturally</u> through Unit 8. Remember that it is normal to rewind several times. Read the workbook instructions carefully and record your answers on a separate piece of paper. Check your answers in the back of the book. If you gave more than two incorrect answers in any given section, watch the videotape again to figure out why you got it wrong, then turn your paper over and do the exercise again.
- 6. Last week you thought about several questions related to money and food. Videotape yourself signing about the last time you spent too much money on food. Where and what did you eat? Another idea is to sign about how much you could spend on a night at the movies if you had plenty of money.
